

Welcome to Winchester Musicals and Opera Society's *The Sound of Musicals*. We are thrilled to be 'on the road', singing an eclectic programme of music for your enjoyment. WMOS usually perform two musicals in Theatre Royal Winchester but this year we are mixing it up: a concert in February, an outdoor production of *The Pirates of Penzance* in the gardens of Wolvesey Palace, Winchester in July and then back to the Theatre Royal in November for the Alan Ayckbourn classic *A Chorus of Disapproval*.

Our society was formed over 100 years ago by Mr Whitwam and Mr Elsemere on 22nd November 1912. They had enjoyed performances in Salisbury by an amateur company and wanted to create something similar for the people of Winchester. The objects of the Society were to 'foster the combined arts of music and drama and encourage their appreciation by an annual operatic production'.

Our first show, 'The Pirates of Penzance', took place in May the following spring, which was performed at what became our regular venue of The Guildhall on The Broadway. There were no productions from 1915-19 and from 1940-46, owing to the First and Second World Wars, but apart from these gaps we have put on a production (or two from 1979) every year since we were founded.

Our Production of 'Made in Dagenham', performed last May, has recently been awarded the National Operatic and Dramatic Association (NODA) Accolade of Excellence.











